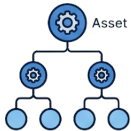

Structured capabilities connecting asset hierarchy, planned maintenance, corrective work, engineering execution, material availability and lifecycle intelligence.



Equipment & Asset Hierarchy

Maintain structured equipment information from parent equipment and assemblies through individual assets, including OEM, make, model, serial number, location, category and supporting technical records.



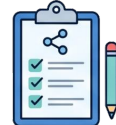
Asset Lifecycle Management

Preserve the equipment lifecycle from purchase, installation and commissioning through warranty, maintenance, repairs, history and eventual decommissioning.



Preventive Planned Maintenance

Configure maintenance routines using calendar, running-hour and usage-based triggers with periodicity, reminders, counter units and maintenance categories.



Unified Work Order Management

Combine planned maintenance routines and breakdown/corrective activities within a single Work Order. Assign one or multiple engineers, coordinate execution and progress the complete scope through controlled closure.



Breakdown Management

Capture equipment breakdowns with failure mode, severity, occurrence information and corrective requirements, linked directly to Work Order execution and equipment history.



Spares & Maintenance Materials

Associate equipment and Work Orders with spares, consumables, lubricants, chemicals and fasteners required for maintenance execution.



Inventory & Stores

Maintain stock, reorder levels, storage location, issues, receipts and returns with traceability of material movement.



Supply Chain Visibility

Connect maintenance-driven demand with Purchase Indents, approvals, purchase-order visibility, delivery status and material receipt.



Gate Pass & TY Loan

Control Gate Pass Inward/Outward and Temporary Loan workflows covering request, approval, issue, receipt, return and closure.



Reliability & Reports

Analyse MTBF, MTTR, planned and unplanned downtime, breakdown trends, asset availability and maintenance performance.

A unified workflow connecting equipment, people, maintenance and material readiness.

Build to preserve one continuous maintenance and asset history through out the vessel lifecycle.

Maintenance Information Should Not Be Fragmented Across Registers, Spreadsheets, Stores Records and Isolated Systems.

Throughout a vessel's operational life, every equipment generates a continuous stream of maintenance information - preventive routines, running hours, breakdowns, work orders, engineering actions, spare consumption, material requests, repairs and replacement history. When this information is fragmented, technical teams spend valuable time reconstructing what happened instead of deciding what must happen next.

Due, overdue, deferred and recently completed maintenance activities.

Equipment History

Previous maintenance, breakdowns, repairs and recurring failure history.

Work Responsibility

Required spares, consumables, lubricants, chemicals and fasteners - with visibility of stock, requests and orders.

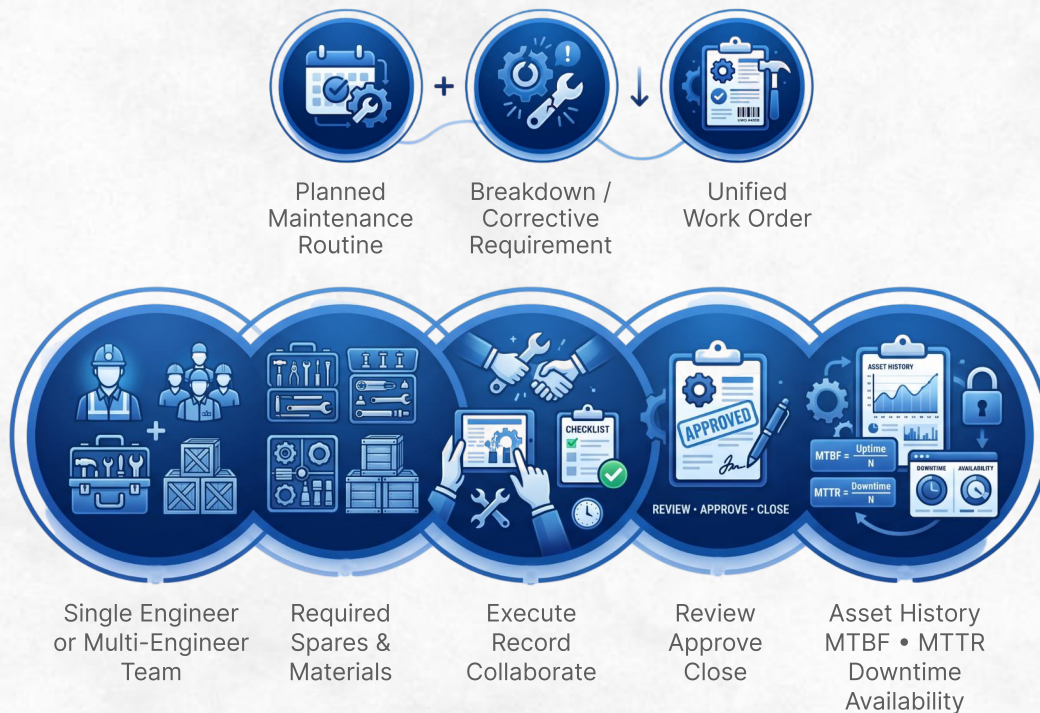
Reliability Performance

Maintenance Discipline

Maritime Material Control

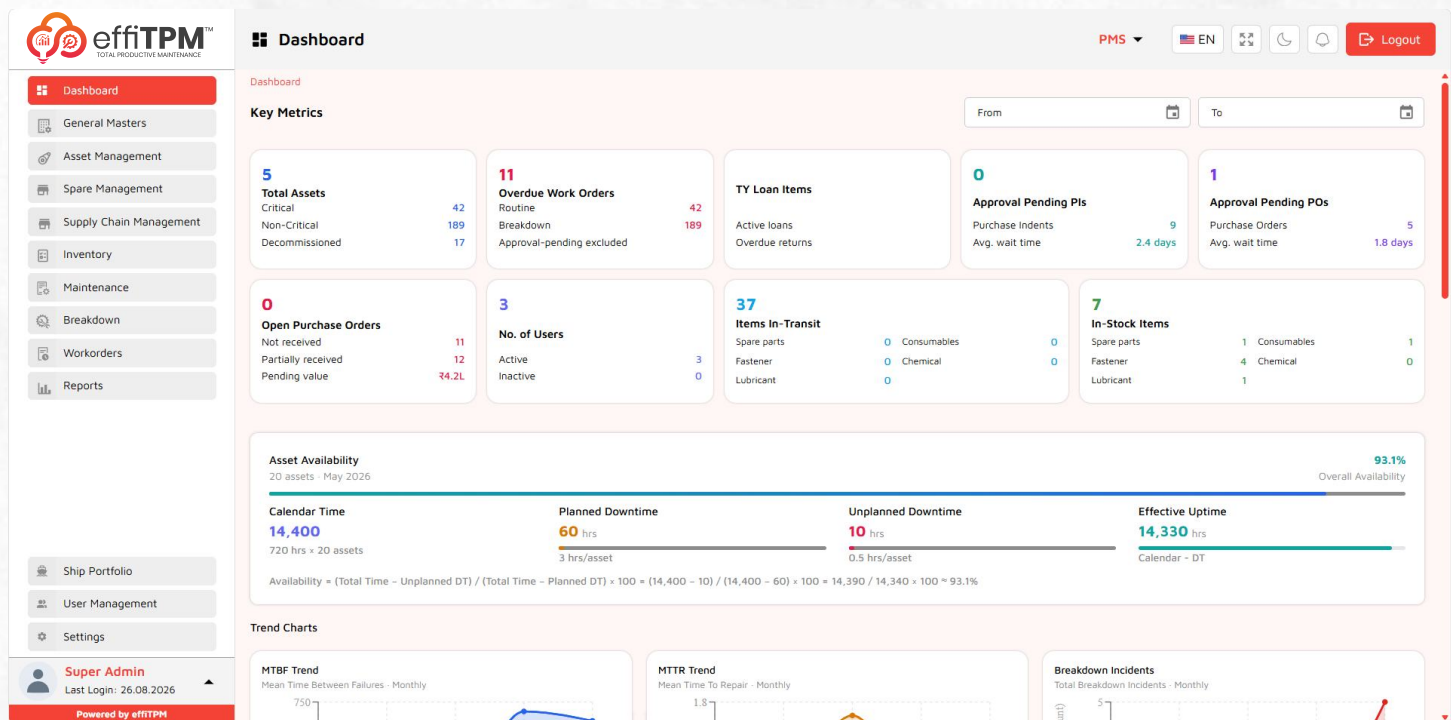
Support operational workflows such as Gate Pass Inward/Outward and TY Loan with controlled approvals, quantities, returns and complete history.
